Make a toilet roll butterfly!

- 1. Paint your toilet roll or cover it in some cool, colourful card!
- 2. Using some different coloured card, cut out some beautiful butterfly wings and antennae. You may want to decorate the wings with some fab patterns, glitter, or stickers. Get creative!
- 3. Glue the wings and antennae onto the toilet roll.
- 4. Time for the face! You can draw or paint some eyes and a happy, smiley mouth. Or maybe you have some cool eyes that you can stick on?
- 5. You're done! Maybe you want to give your new winged friend a name?

Make a leaf butterfly!

This one is super simple. Head outside and see what you can find. Ideally, you want some nice big leaves for your butterfly's wings, then something like a pine cone or a twig for its body. You can stick all of this onto some card, add some eyes, decorate the leaf wings and be really awesome and creative! We can't wait to see what you come up with!
